Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Incorporated was organized on November 12, 1922 in Indianapolis, Indiana by seven young educators. Built on the hallmark of educational excellence, Mary Lou Little, Dorothy Whiteside, Vivian Marbury, Nannie Johnson, Hattie Redford, Bessie Martin and Cubena McClure dedicated their lives to educating and enhancing the quality of life for women around the world. Originally a teachers' organization dedicated to the academic excellence of youth, an official charter was granted to the Alpha Chapter at Butler University on December 30, 1929, making it an incorporated national collegiate sorority.
